BIOSEK Invitation to all beef producers to participate in a National Disease Prevention Plan.

Developed by V-NET, Dr Danie Odendaal.

Veterinarian Network introduced a national monthly disease reporting system for veterinarians more than 10 years ago. This has culminated in a comprehensive overview of disease trends that occur per region and nationally.

This was done in cooperation with the Ruminant Veterinary Association (RuVASA). With Dr Faffa Malan, as the very enthusiastic driver, veterinarians are urged to report on an ongoing basis and this information is then also shared monthly in various forms on the website of RuVASA and for publication in the agricultural media.

Feedback from cattle breeders and veterinarians has indicated that there is a need to use this valuable information in a more practical way for the advantage of herd health on a national basis.

With the "higher-than-normal" rainfall experienced in large parts of the country this year higher levels of disease occurrence is expected and requires timeous preventive planning.

To put words into actions, Veterinarian Network will kick off the year by providing a guideline for the structured development or revision of a new or existing vaccination plan for use by beef cattle farmers in consultation with their designated herd veterinarians.

The **basic structure** of the 12 monthly vaccination plan for beef cattle is very simple as in the example herein below. The challenge is the timely execution that will require further dedication.

The yearly vaccination plan must give an overview of the 3 variables.

1. The 12 months of the year that also correlate with the 4 different seasons.
2. Management of all age groups such as replacement animals must be dealt with separately.
3. The 4 production periods of the breeding season must be included in the plan.

2. All the different management of age groups (replacement animals) and
3. The different stages of production (4 Production Periods) must be represented.

Participation is free of charge and the vaccination guideline divided into 4 practical consecutive sections will be send by the Veterinarian Network in an electronic format to cattle farmers and their herd veterinarians.

The only prerequisite is that every beef cattle farmer that is interested to receive the guideline must personally register his/her interest.

1. The principles concerning effective vaccination. Methodology for the layout of a year plan and structured determination of the diseases which is or can be a problem on the farm, and which can be prevented by vaccination.
2. Practical step x step layout of the vaccination plan [spreadsheet] for the development or revision of the yearly vaccination plan as well as the budget for the ordering of these vaccines.
3. Explanation of the monthly action lists (reminders) and checklists that can be used to ensure that vaccinations are done as planned.
4. Advice on using the vaccination records and the use thereof for marketing purposes when calves are sold to the feedlots or cattle are sold for breeding purposes.

This project will be discussed further, analysed and evaluated for ongoing implementation at the yearly conference of the Ruminant Veterinary Association (RuVASA) which is held in May 2023.



For it to work and to benefit the industry amongst others in restoring our national animal health status internationally we need the interest and dedication of both the cattle farmers and the veterinarians who provide a herd health service.



BIOSEK Uitnodiging aan alle vleisbeesboere om deel te neem aan 'n nasionale siektevoorkomingsplan. Verskaf deur V-NET opgestel deur Dr Danie Odendaal

Veearts Netwerk het meer as 10 jaar gelede 'n nasionale siekterapporteringstelsel daar gestel waardeer veeartse reg deur die land, op 'n maandelikse basis, die siektes rapporteer soos dit voorkom, met die doel om 'n volledige siekte oorsig te kry van die siektes wat per streek, provinsie en op 'n landswye basis voorkom. Dit word gedoen in samewerking met die Herkouer Veearts Vereniging. Dr Fappa Malan is die drywer wat ongelooflike goeie werk doen om die veeartse op 'n maandelikse basis aan te spoor om die rapportering te doen, en dan ook die siektevoorkom deur te gee na die landboumedia.

Met die terugvoer wat ontvang is vanaf veeboere en die veeartse is dit duidelik dat daar 'n behoefte bestaan om hierdie waardevolle inligting wat so versamel is, op 'n meer praktiese wyse aan te wend ten voordeel van die veebedryf.

Dit is veral van belang in die uitsonderlike nat jaar wat ons nou beleef in die grootste gedeelte van die land, met die siekte uitdaging wat daarmee gepaard gaan.

Om daad by die woord te sit, wil Veearts Netwerk die nuwe jaar afskop deur aan elke vleisbeesboer en hulle aangewese kuddeveearts, 'n riglyne deur te gee vir die gestructureerde opstel of hersiening van 'n bestaande inentingsplan vir die vleisbeeskudde.

Die **struktuur** van 'n 12 maandelikse vleisbeesentingsplan is eenvoudig soos in die voorbeeld uitleg hieronder, maar die opstel en uitvoering van die entingsplan het toegewyde bestuur nodig.



Jaarlikse entingsplan moet 'n oorsig gee van 3 veranderlikes:

1. Die 12 maande van die jaar wat ook gekoppel is aan die 4 verskillende seisoene,
2. Al die verskillende bestuurs- of ouderdomsgroepe(vervangingsvers) en
3. Die verskillende stadia van produksie(4 ProduksiePeriodes)

Die vier afdelings van die riglyne vir die inwerkingstelling van 'n doeltreffende inentingplan sal die volgende inligting bevat:

4. Beskrywing van die doel van entingsrekords, en die gebruik daarvan in die bemarking van beeste wat aan voerkrale of vir teeldoeleindes verkoop word.
